As part of our science study on 'Electricity', a school trip to Magna (a science adventure centre in Rotherham) has been organised for the Year 4 pupils. The visits will take place on Wednesday 22⁻⁻⁻ May and Thursday 23⁻⁻⁻ May, and the arrangements for the classes are as follows:

Wednesday 22[™] May – Class 4BG and 4JM Thursday 23[™] May – Class 4KH and 4DM

We will be travelling by coach, and shall be leaving school at 9.00 a.m. and returning by 3.05 p.m. on each of the days.

Whilst at Magna, the children will be exploring the Discovery Centre where they will gain hands-on experience of science and see fascinating displays in the four pavilions – Air, Earth, Fire and Water. They will also be engaging in a workshop 'The Big Circuit' which will be led by staff at Magna.

Your child will require a packed lunch on the day (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). Children who normally have a free school meal will be provided with a packed lunch (if your child has any special dietary requirements, please inform the school as soon as possible). Any medication which your child needs, and which you have completed school documentation for (such as inhalers) must be sent to school with your child on the day of the trip.

School uniform, including sensible, sturdy shoes, will need to be worn and a coat will also be required as the centre is cold inside throughout the year.

We ask for a voluntary contribution of £10.00 towards the cost of the trip by Friday 19th April at the latest (this covers the cost of entry to the science centre, the cost of the workshop as well as part payment towards transport costs). Payment should be made via ParentPay. It is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions, it will not be possible for the trip to take place and it will be cancelled. Spending money of no more than £5.00 is optional.

If you would like your child to go, please complete the attached slip and return it (and make the required payment) as soon as possible. If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher or myself.
