2. Rehearse their Multiplication Tables. TTRS (Times tables rock stars) can be accessed via the app or via <https://play.ttrockstars.com/auth/school/student> - five one minute games in the 'garage' is best as this aspect of the game targets what your child needs to develop.
3. Spelling homework - spellings are provided each week.
