

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for expressing an interest in the residential trip. We are now in a position where we can offer **80 places** to the pupils for a residential at PGL Caythorpe Court activity centre, Grantham. This trip will be a two night residential from the **12th - 14th June 2024** and will be a total price of **£150 per child**. This price includes accommodation in the **tent village**, coach, food and ten activities over the three days. These activities will be confirmed nearer the time but will include activities such as abseiling, rock climbing, orienteering, archery and a disco in the evening.

To secure your child's place, a **non-refundable deposit of £40 will be required by Monday 5th February**. Payment must be paid on ParentPay. If you require support with this, please contact the school office. If payment is not made by this date, we will assume your child does not want to attend the trip.

To spread the cost of the trip, we are giving parents the option of paying the balance in intervals.

Payment 2 **due by 15th March: £40**

Payment 3 **due by 15th April: £50**

Payment 4 **due by 24th May: £20**
