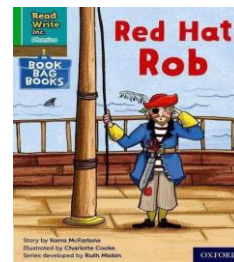


Dear Families,

You will have noticed your child bringing home a variety of reading books, here we explain what each one is for and how it helps your child to read.

### **Book 1- A Read Write Inc. Book Bag Book.**

This is a fully decodable reading book (the children can segment and blend the words) for your child to read at home to support their Read Write Inc (phonics learning in the classroom). The Book Bag Books also include notes for you on how to help your child at home with their phonics. Below is an example of what your child will bring home:



At the end of each book unit, children will also bring home the phonics book that they have been reading in class with their phonics teacher. This is a black and white book which will look like the one below:

These two books are Phonics Reading Books and are designed to develop fluency and accuracy of reading - it is expected that your child will read these with you for a minimum of 20 minutes, three times per week. Please ensure you initial the weekly reading log (in your child's planner) after your child has read to an adult and please feel free to add any comments about this. **These books must be in school everyday with your child.**



Your child will also bring home a book that they have selected from our library. These books are for you to read with your child to develop their **love of reading**. These books are not linked to our phonics scheme so are not designed to develop fluency or accuracy. These can be changed as often as your child needs.

Your child may not be on our RWInc phonics programme and therefore they will bring home one of our Accelerated Reader books which they can read at home and take a book quiz on in school.
