

Dear Parents/Carers,

To support our topic on WW2, Year 6 will be visiting the National Holocaust Centre and Museum in Newark on **Tuesday 27th February 2023**. This is a highly engaging trip where the pupils will learn about a young Jewish boy named Leo. Pupils will be taken through a series of rooms, each designed to authentically represent a time period in Nazi Germany and a stage in Leo's personal journey. They will also have the opportunity to listen to a Holocaust survivor tell their story.

Children will be required to wear uniform and will need a packed lunch on the day. If your child receives free school meals then a packed lunch will be provided. No glass bottles or fizzy drinks please. There will **not** be an opportunity to visit the gift shop and so your child **does not** need any additional money on the day.

If your child has an inhaler, they must carry this at all times. Please ensure the school has up-to-date information about any medical needs your child has.

It is important that your child is on time for school (8:35 am) as the coach will be leaving promptly after registration. We will return to school a little later than usual to allow pupils to take part in workshops and to fully experience the Holocaust Centre. **Pupils will return to school at 4pm** and will leave school as usual through either the main entrance or Cemetery Road.

*We ask for a voluntary contribution of £11 towards the cost of the trip by Friday 20th January 2023 which should be paid via ParentPay. Please do not send cash into school. We have sent this information as soon as possible to allow parents time to raise the funds. School has already made a significant contribution to the cost of this trip to try and keep costs at a minimum for you. **It is important for us to stress that in the event of an inadequate number of parental contributions it will not be possible for the trip to take place and it will be cancelled.***
